CAMPER REQUIREMENTS:

Ages 5-12 are eligible to enroll as long as they have at least completed kindergarten.

We are unable to enroll children that will be turning 13 before the last day of camp due to licensing regulations. We will be accepting 32 campers on a first come, first enrolled basis.

EXTRA CLOTHES:
